### Multi-Member Discounts

Register a **minimum of two employees** under the same company and save on membership fees. After the Primary member, each subsequent employee will pay the Multi-Member price of \$130.00 +HST. Two memberships would be \$285.00+\$130.00+HST=\$468.95. There is no limit to how many Multi-Members a company can have.

### Associate Membership Eligibility

To join as an 'Associate' member you must be involved in an organization, association or interest group related to the wastewater industry such as the Ontario Building Officials Association (**OBOA**), Ontario Association of Sewage Industry Services (**OASIS**), Ontario Society of Professional Engineers (**OSPE**), Ontario Association of Home Inspectors (**OAHI**) or the Canadian Water Quality Association (CWQA). If you are a part of a similar industry association, please let us know.

This member designation is intended to engage those who are interested in OOWA and the onsite wastewater industry but whose core focus may be elsewhere. ### Young Professional Membership Eligibility

To join as a young professional, you must be 30 years of age or younger. **Proof of age is required and will be requested.**

To join as a student member, enrollment in a full-time post-secondary education program in a related or affiliated discipline is required. **Proof of full-time enrollment or full-time student status is required and will be requested.**
