Key Roles and Responsibilities:

1. In-Field Sampling, Maintenance, Repair and Reporting

Our environmental wastewater technicians are responsible for the routine maintenance, sampling, and repair of onsite wastewater (septic) systems and advanced wastewater treatment technologies. Sampling and reporting are also an important part of regular duties. We provide comprehensive training and support for everything our technicians need to know. The understanding and following of our procedures, while maintaining discretion and professionalism at all times, is essential.

As our client base can be found all over the province, scheduled routes with appointment times and service descriptions are provided. Corporate service vehicles are provided and extensive driving in various weather conditions can be expected.

2. In-Field Service Calls and Customer Support

On occasion service calls, and unscheduled diagnostic or emergency site visits may be required. With the support of on-call administrative instruction and scheduling staff, you may be asked and dispatched to perform these duties.
